We focus on Three Dimensions which is the Focus Dimension, Centering Dimension and Laterality Dimension. Higher-level functions depend on lower level-functions, our neurological system is hierarchical. To master reading, writing, and talking our lower-level functions such as visual and auditory perception must support the higher-level functions.

Through our senses we gather information and then the brain can process the information. Reflexes must be in place to be able to learn effectively and to support the learning process. Movement is an educational investment and part of our way of teaching. Lofland Private Nature Schooling Centre is where we tutor children who need to learn in a way that the body knows BEST.
